
## THANK YOU!

It is no secret this year's shelter went so smoothly in part because of the City of Wheeling opening up the space in the former Hillcrest facility to us. One cannot underestimate the impact separate bedrooms and bathrooms with showers can have on a person's dignity and overall attitude and health.

We have worked this season to place 17 people into housing, with nine more on waiting lists. We have provided transporation for 16 of our guests to live with relatives or friends out of town.

You, our donors, are the only reason we can provide these life-saving, life-affirming services. Our generous community never lets us down. Year after year, you prove that you see your unsheltered neighbors, you care about
