WHEELING, W.Va — Youth Services System, Inc. (YSS), in conjunction with the Wheeling YWCA, is offering a Recovery Coach Academy in September for National Recovery Month. The dates are September 12-16, from 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. daily. The course will be facilitated by Valery Staskey of YSS and Jennifer Sorg of the YWCA.

The Connecticut Community for Addiction Recovery (CCAR) course is a 30-hour training offered over one week. It is nationally recognized as one of the leading courses to learn the art and practice of coaching those with substance use disorders. Anyone who is interested may sign up for the course – there are no prerequisites.
